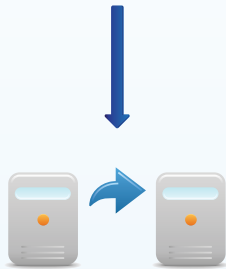


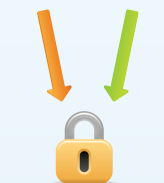

OMNIPRINT - Client Setup Process

How to Work with OmniPrint

This outline lists all the POSSIBLE steps involved in becoming an OmniPrint user. Depending on the customer and their needs, some of these steps will not be necessary as OmniPrint is the most flexible card fulfillment option available today.

Step	Description	Check Off
1) Setup OmniPrepaid Account	Simply login to www.omniprepaidgroup.com and sign up for a new account, or one of our Sales Executives will sign you up for an account right over the phone.	
2) Signup for OmniPrint Service	Once you have an account, you can sign up for the OmniPrint service.	
3) Create At Least One test Package <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Upload Artwork b. Setup Card Information c. Setup Carrier Information 	<p>In OmniPrint, each type of card that you would like to produce is called a package. Simply setup at least one package by adding the appropriate artwork and describing the card to our system.</p> <p>Barcode or Magnetic Stripe Embossed or Printed Text Location of Text Etc.</p> <p>OmniPrint gives you complete control over the design of each card.</p>	
4) Produce Test Card	Once you are finished setting up your Package, simply submit a test and OmniPrint will produce a test card to your specifications.	
5) Setup Connection <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Select Connection Type b. (SSH, SFTP, FTPS, VPN) c. Send Test File 	In order for OmniPrint to receive regular file transfers, a file transfer mechanism must be established with you or your processor. There are numerous technical options when determining this connection type, and OmniPrint is flexible to work with most industry standards.	
6) Determine File Encryption Scheme <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. PGP, AES, Blowfish, etc. b. Exchange Public Keys c. Send Test File (Encrypt/Decrypt) 	If you are sending secure card data to OmniPrint, we require those files to be transmitted securely and encrypted. OmniPrint will work with your technical staff to determine the easiest and safest way to secure your data.	
7) Determine Import File Format <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Send File Spec and Test File b. OmniPrint parses file and maps to proprietary OmniPrint format c. Create test cards from test file 	Each customer has their own format for sending card data to a fulfillment house, and OmniPrint can work with any one of them. If you currently do not have your own file structure, OmniPrint will provide the specifications for our own flexible file structure.

How to Work with OmniPrint

Step	Description	Check Off
8) End to End Test a. Customer sends a live, encrypted file to OmniPrint b. OmniPrint fulfills cards	Once all the connections are established, we perform a full test to make sure that all pieces are working on both ends. You transmit a file to OmniPrint via the newly created connection, and OmniPrint automatically fulfills your order within 24 hours. During this test, OmniPrint reps will verify the test order to ensure smooth operation.	
9) Customer Tests Live Cards	Once OmniPrint has verified the order, the cards are sent to you for your final testing and approval.	
Once final testing has been completed, you are LIVE. Congratulations on becoming an OmniPrint customer and welcome to the world of customized card production.
